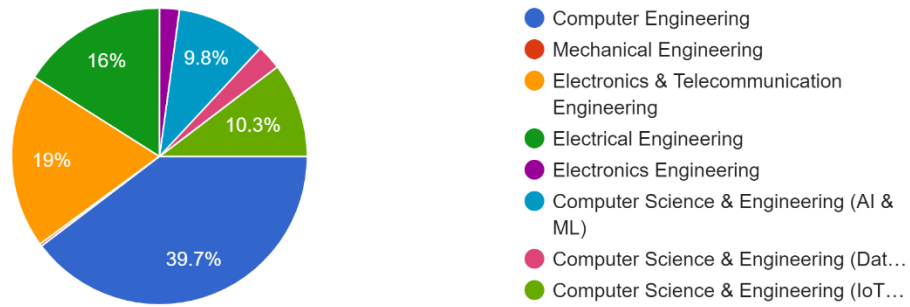

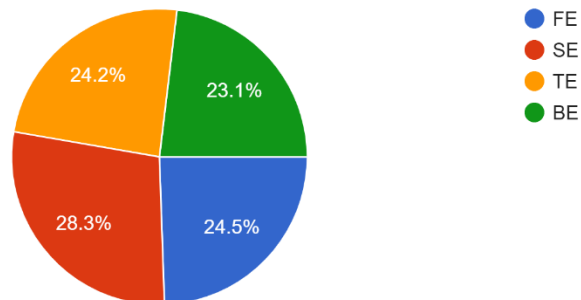

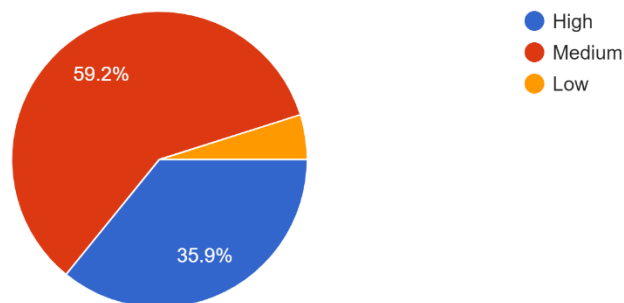

Is the inclusion of the new subjects in the curriculum relevant for contemporary needs?

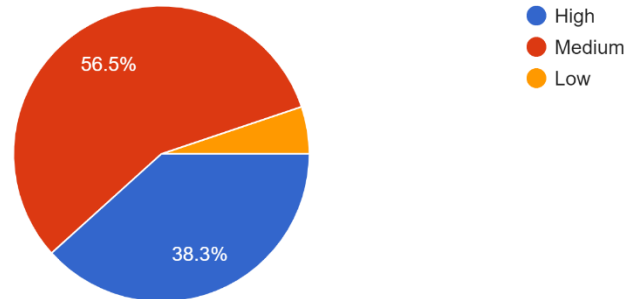

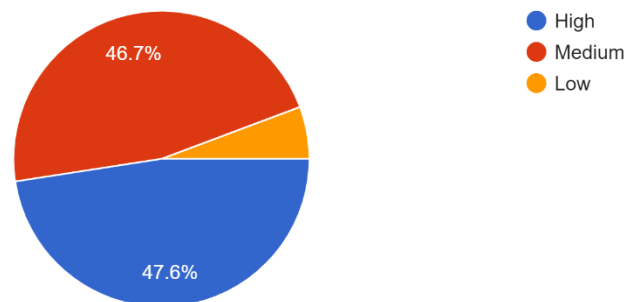

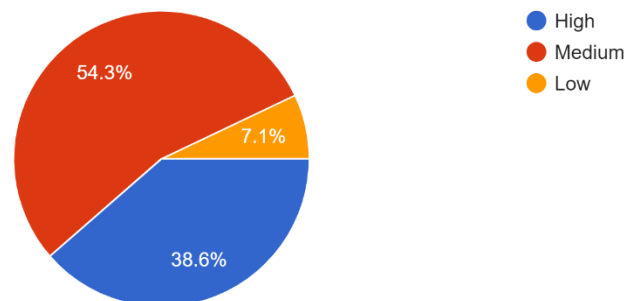

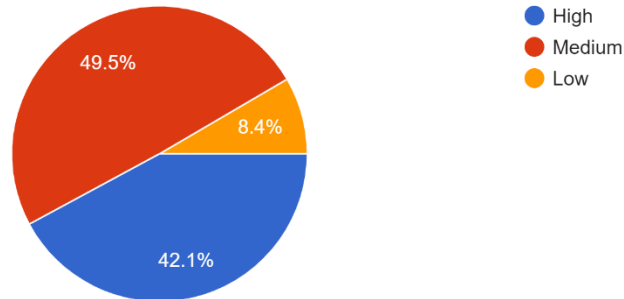

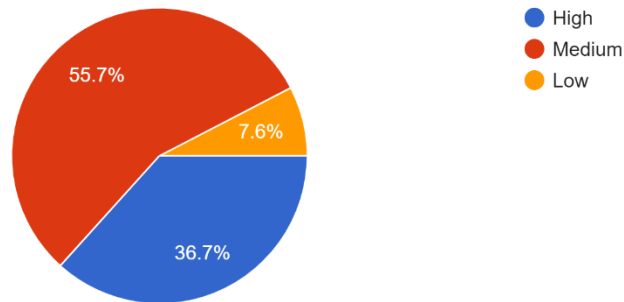

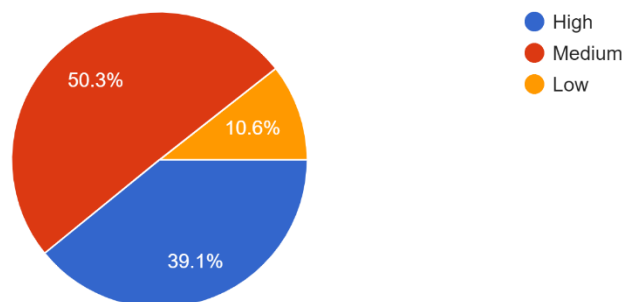

Satisfaction level of syllabus covered in the class

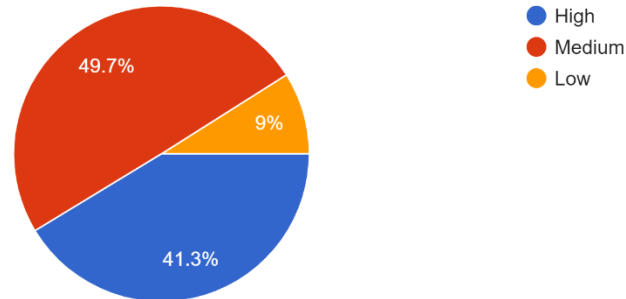

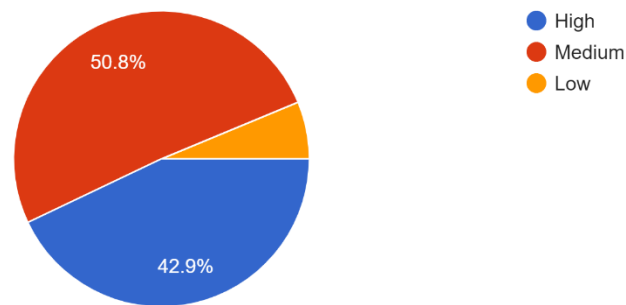
Satisfaction level with respect to the facilities provided by the institute

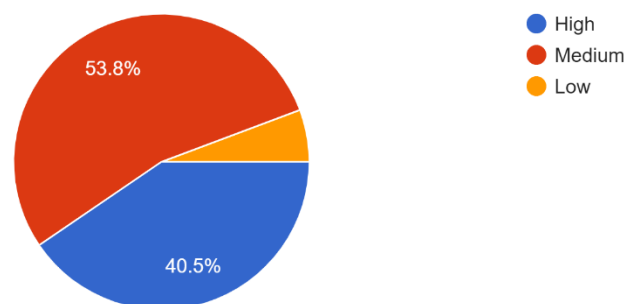
Satisfaction level with respect to the usage of ICT tools & teaching skills of faculty members.

As per the responses received from various students, a mixed response was observed for most of the points related to curriculum. Some students suggested for a reduction in the number of subjects



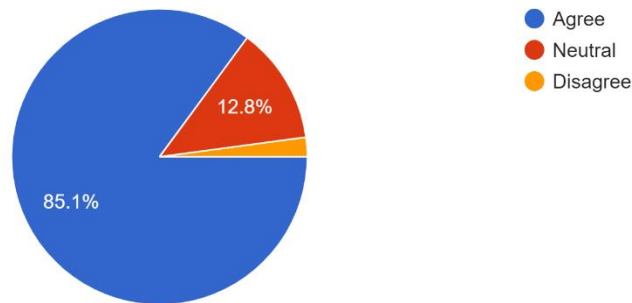

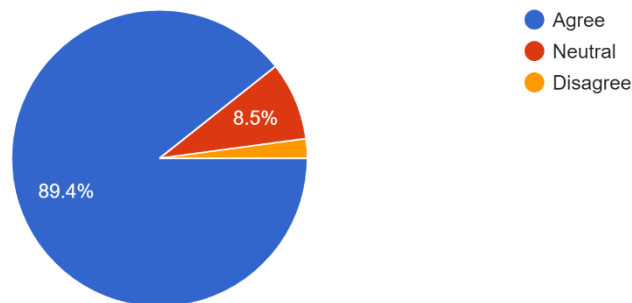
Curriculum is as per the current trends and need of the students

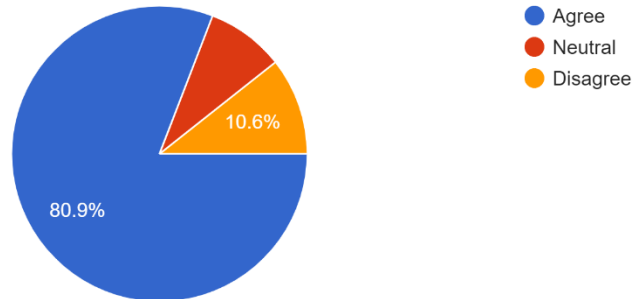

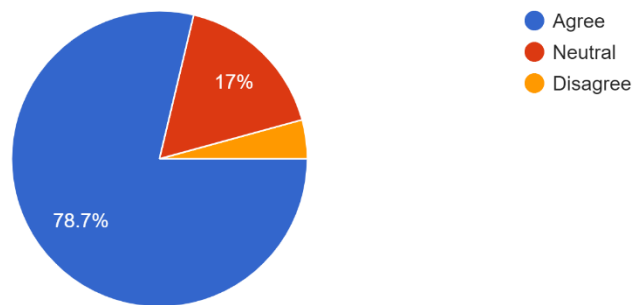

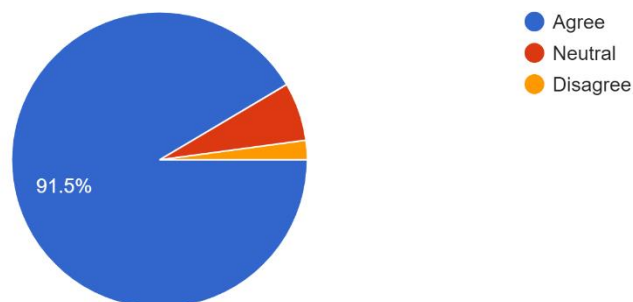

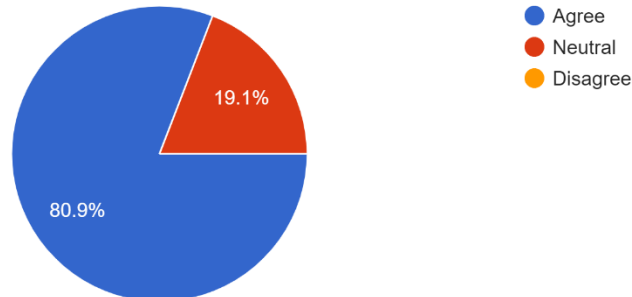

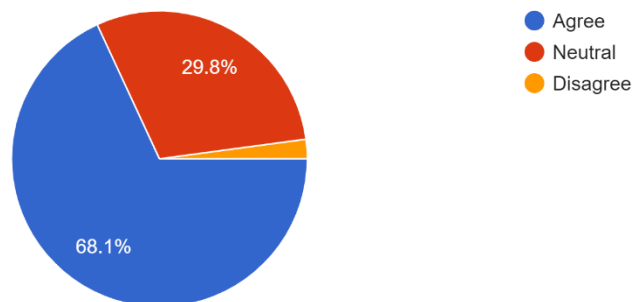

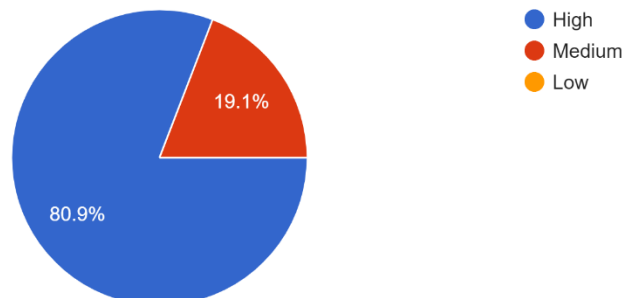

As per the responses received from various teachers it was observed that 85% of the teachers agree that the curriculum is as per the current trends and needs of the students. 89% of the faculty



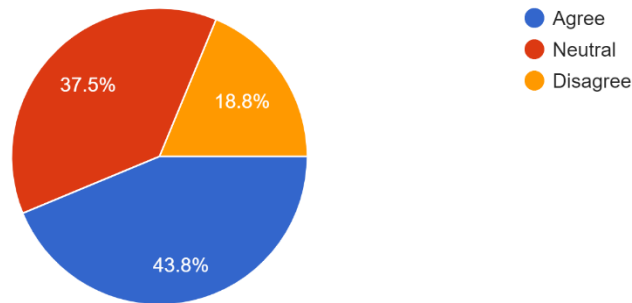

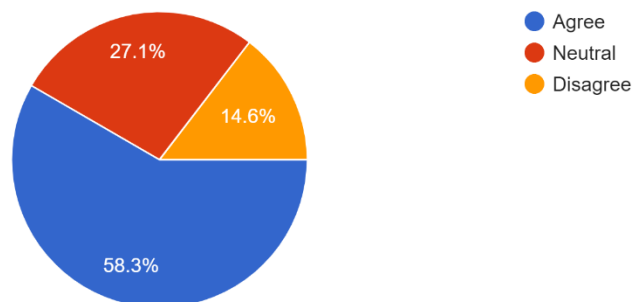

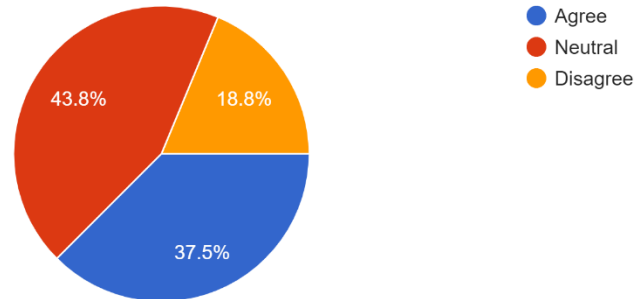

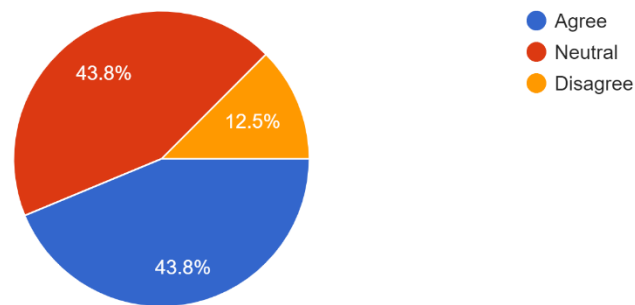

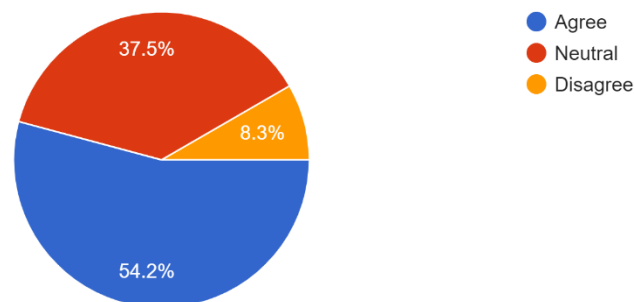

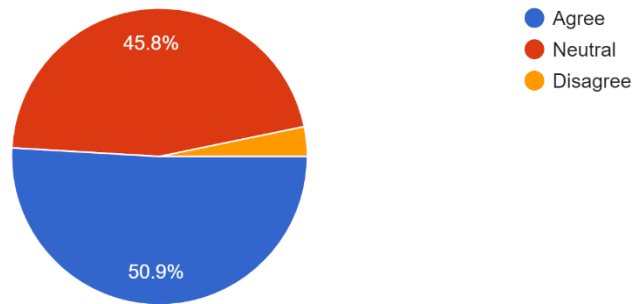
It was observed that 54% alumni agreed that the curriculum meets the industry needs and motivates self learning. However it can be improved further.

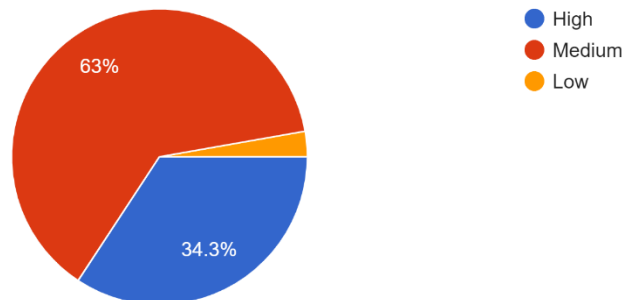
Curriculum meets the requirements for employability?

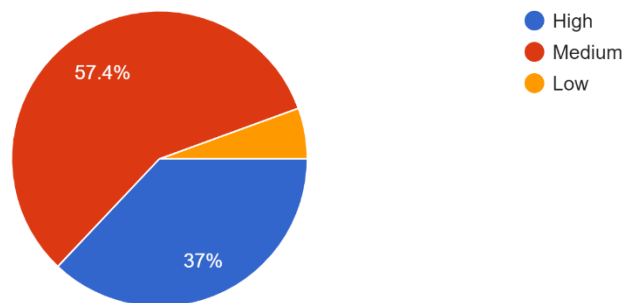
Learning experience of your ward through the curriculum

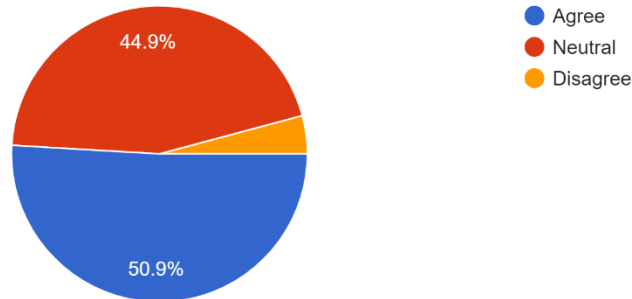

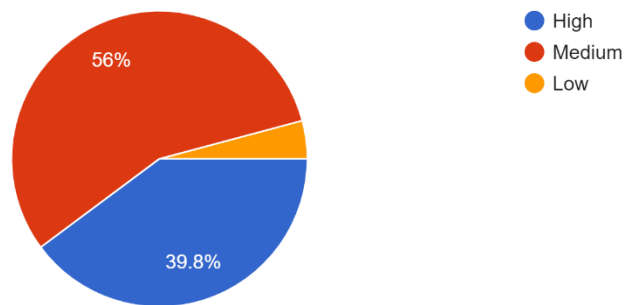

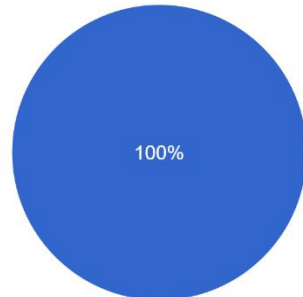

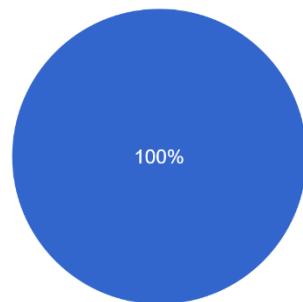

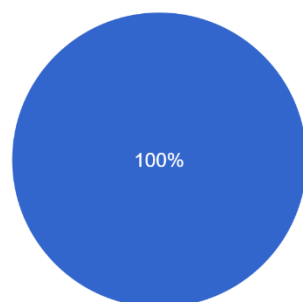

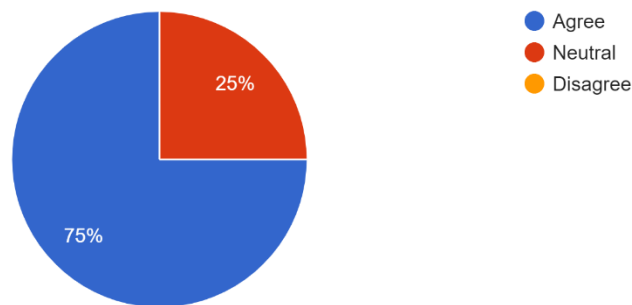
Effectiveness of curriculum for development of entrepreneurship

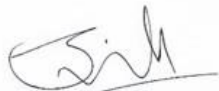
